


## Why We're All Here....

- Growing number of persons experiencing homelessness in Langley
- City initiative to address the challenge through a Homelessness Strategic Plan
- Langley Homelessness Task Force
- Focused on strategies and solutions rooted in the Langley context



#### **Process**






- First deliverable

- Contributors: service providers, government statistics, RCMP

There are 92 people experiencing homelessness in Langley






- Of persons experiencing homelessness in Langley, 43% have lived in the Langleys for less than 1 year
- In Langley, youth represent 22% of persons experiencing homelessness
- Seniors are a growing segment of persons accessing services, and represent 15% of persons experiencing homelessness
- Aboriginals makeup 6% of Langley's total population, but represent 16% of persons experiencing homelessness
  - Only 15% of Aboriginal persons experiencing homelessness access shelters in Langley

- In 2014, 42% of Bylaw calls involved persons experiencing homelessness
- RCMP has seen an increase in calls related to persons experiencing homelessness, from Bylaw related to unspecified assistance:
  - 131 calls in 2012 to 483 calls in 2014



- Gateway of Hope annually serve 700+ unique men and women
- Starting Point Homeless Outreach Services served a total of 367 unique clients between April 2014-March 2015
  - 38% of clients homeless less than 1 month
  - 36% of clients homeless for a period of 1 to 6 months





### **Social Services Inventory**

- Second deliverable
- Original prepared in 2008
- Outlines social services available to Langley residents, specifically low-income households and persons experiencing homelessness or at-risk of homelessness

## **Social Services Inventory**

- Changes since 2008
- Merger = Encompass Support Services Society
- Closing soup kitchen and drop-in service (St. Josephs)
- Several new services... grown from 32 to 75...many targeting youth and seniors
- Potential gaps in services
