

EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES

Langley is home to one of the largest school districts in BC, with 42 elementary and secondary schools in Greater Langley, and more specifically, 6 schools within the City of Langley's 10 square kilometer boundary. Langley is also home to Kwantlen Polytechnic University, the world-renowned Langley Community Music School, and the nearby Trinity Western University.

The community offers a broad spectrum of education programs for all ages, from elementary school to university. Educational opportunities include Trades (such as carplumbing, automotive, electrical engineering and hair dressing), Journalism, Horticultu French Immersion, Business, Science, Health Care, Mathematics, IT, Fine Arts, and mo

With a central location, affordable housing, plenty of urban amenities, and a strong economy, the City of Langley is a great place to live and learn.

CENTRAL LOCATION

Located enroute between Surrey and Abbotsford (along Highway #10 and Fraser Highway), and between the three major USA border crossings and the nearby Abbotsford International Airport, the City of Langley is at the crossroads for many travelers and commuters, thereby serving a much larger population than our local community.

POPULATION

The City of Langley is located in the centre of the Lower Mainland Region, from Vancouver to Hope. This area is made up of two districts: Metro Vancouver (population: 2.1 million, with an annual growth rate of 6.5%) and the Fraser Valley Regional District (population: 278,000, with an annual growth rate of 8.2%). (STATISTICS CANADA, 2006)

Langley City (population: 25,000 in 10 square km) is surrounded by Langley Township (population: 104,000) and is situated at the eastern edge of Metro Vancouver. The City of Langley enjoys a 30-minute commuting population of more than 1 million people. It's local trade area is estimated at 310,000 people, representing a \$4.6 billion market. (RETAIL TRADE AREA STUDY, 2012-2016).

QUALITY OF LIFE

Within the City of Langley's 10 square km area, there are more jobs than there are available employees. The average household income in the trade area is about \$95,000. Cost of living in Langley is significantly lower than Vancouver. Housing is about 63% lower than Vancouver, ranging from about \$205,000 for an apartment to about \$530,000 for a detached home.
