3) **DISCUSSION**

a) 2022 Work Plan

Rotary Centennial Park Mural

Michael Paylor contacted Makers Cube regarding project and they are interested in partnering with Committee. Michael will continue dialogue with Makers Cube, discussion to include: theme, material, equipment and other required resources.

ACTION: Kim Hilton to forward mural dimensions and arrange visit to mural site.

Glover Road Gateway

Need to await funding approval.

Langley Heritage Railway

Committee members to contact volunteer and determine steps going forward, including a budget and obtaining final sign proofs.

Artists in the Park

Discussion to work with Langley Arts Council on the project and combine with a Concert Series at Spirit Stage.

Artisan Event

Discussion to work with Langley Arts Council on the project and plan for a Fall or Spring event.

ACTION: Clare (LAC), David Johnson and Kim Hilton will meet/discuss this item further and report back to Committee.

Performance Art Theatre

Committee discussed possibility of incorporating youth population and heritage/cultural influences.

Partnering with Langley City "Summer Series" may be an option for this item.

Cultural Displays

David suggested a comic book display like the one he has attended in Yaletown.

Markers in Douglas Park

Val Newson shared there are 17 languages represented at Langley Community Services.

Committee discussed project to use markers in Douglas Park as way to display the depth/breadth of heritage and culture in Langley City.

b) Review of Filming and Locations in Langley City

The number of films and diversity of material filmed in Langley City is impressive.

Committee discussed idea of a hosting an “ARCH Film Festival” every two years, beginning next year.

Michael, David, Rosemary and Tera Edell to form a subcommittee for the “2023 ARCH Film Festival”.

c) Mural Regulations Bylaw

Bylaw needs to incorporate language which clarifies difference between city property and private/business property. As well, approval process for a mural on city property should be clearly defined.

ACTION: Councillor Albrecht will meet with City CAO to obtain clarity on the matter and report back to Committee.

d) Youth Committee

Dena Ojaghi shared tentative schedule of activities being planned by Committee during “Youth Week”. Schedule includes: booth at Community Walk, Games, Tasting Kitchen, Art Show and Fair at Douglas Park. All activities will have a multicultural theme.

The Youth Committee is also planning activities during Pride Month. One of the projects will be a Mural. LAC may be able to assist with this project.

ACTION: To facilitate this possibility Kim Hilton will share contact information of David Johnson (LAC) with Taran Kingsbury, Youth Recreation Leader (LC).

e) 55+ BC Games Bid Application Package

Bid Application Package shared with Committee.

City hosted successfully with Township of Langley in 2014. From experience this type of undertaking is labor intensive but very rewarding.

Committee is in support of Kim Hilton contacting Township of Langley regarding their interest in submitting a bid.

f) Arts, Recreation, Culture and Heritage Terms of Reference

TOR for an Arts, Recreation, Culture and Heritage Committee will be distributed.

Committee will need to actively recruit volunteers from following areas: heritage, multicultural, indigenous, senior and performing arts.
