Youth Week, May 1-7

Framework:

Sunday, May 1

Booth at the Langley Community Walk. Plan to lay out long pieces of parchment paper on tables, sheltered by tents. Each parchment strip to have theme as determined by a word in different language written on the paper. Walk participants will be invited to draw or add to the parchment paper using supplied charcoal or black paint.
