

As food & drink establishments re-open, this guide shows how you can extend your dining area onto the sidewalk in front of your business to serve more customers, maintain physical distancing, & take advantage of the warm sunny weather.

### 1. Ensure You Meet Our Requirements

Make sure your plans meet these requirements:

- Verify that your planned patio is on a public sidewalk – contact the City of Langley at engineering@langleycity.ca if you are uncertain.
- A clear sidewalk width of 2 metres or more must remain open for pedestrians on the sidewalk.
- Patios must be at least 0.6 metres from the curb.
- Exits from buildings must not be blocked.

And, provide verification that you have \$5 million in liability insurance with the City of Langley named as additional insured on the policy.

# 2. Apply for a Sidewalk Permit ("Highway Use Permit") – no fee required!

Contact <a href="mailto:engineering@langleycity.ca">engineering@langleycity.ca</a> to get/submit your application. Fill out the <a href="mailto:application">application</a> and provide a sketch of your plans for the sidewalk, including:

- The location of the patio relative to the property, host building, and City sidewalk, curb, and street.
- Any fencing used to separate the seating area.
  Note: Only required for liquor service.

If you have a <u>Food Primary Liquor Licence</u> and are intending to serve liquor outdoors, follow these additional steps:

- 3. Apply to the BC Liquor and Cannabis Regulation Branch (LCRB) for a Temporary Service Area Expansion Authorization no fee required!
  - This authorization is effective until October 31, 2021.

#### 4. Provide Proof of Licencing to City of Langley

 Once approved by the LCRB, provide proof of licencing to the City of Langley for our records.

## 5. Provide sketch of fencing or other barriers

- If you haven't already, provide a sketch to the City of Langley showing the location of any materials used to define the outdoor dining area.
- If you've already submitted your Highway Use Permit application, send in an updated sketch.
