























































| <b>Watering sand-based playing fields</b>  |   |   |   |   | <b>Stages 1 &amp; 2:</b> On any day from 7 pm to 9 am except if watering newly over-seeded fields if in compliance with a City of Langley permit, or if operating under an approved City of Langley Water Use Management Plan<br><b>Stage 3:</b> No more than 5 days in a 7-day period from 7 pm to 9 am (same exceptions as in Stages 1 & 2)  |
